Duration of Voluntary Placement

1 - 12 months

Minimum Age

20 years old

Professional Prerequisites

It is essential that you like children and are able to offer them love. We want all interested participants to be able to contribute and we do not ask for specific professional prerequisites from our volunteers.

It is however essential that you are flexible, able to adapt and integrate, enjoy communicating and bring a readiness to join in throughout the whole of your stay at the Children's home.

Main responsibilities of Volunteers

- Give the children your attention and affection
- Support at mealtimes
- Collect children from school
- Homework support
- Plan and organise leisure activities
- Some housework
- Share cultural awareness with the children

Work Hours

The working day is between 6 and 8 hours

You will work six days a week, with one free day, which can be taken during the week.

We need all volunteers working during the weekend, since all the children are then at home.

Accommodation

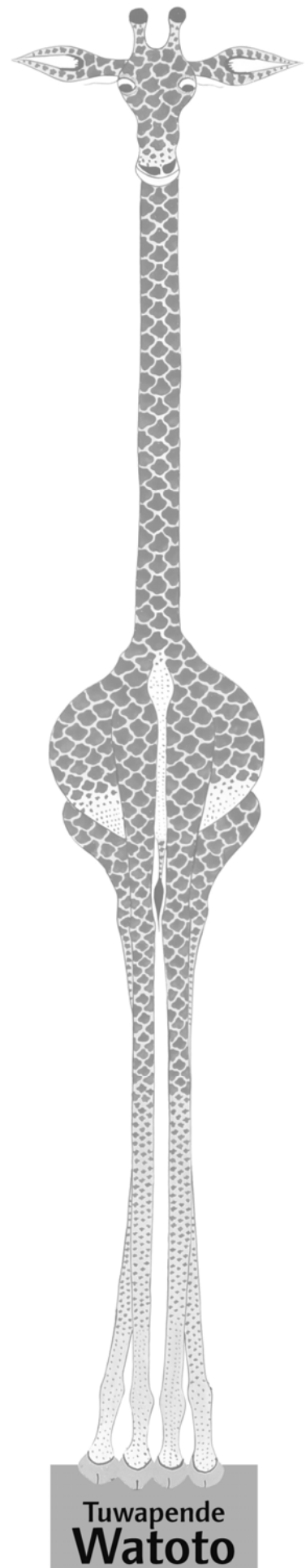
Your accommodation during your stay is on the premises of the children's home.
