The Tuwapende Watoto Foundation provides a bright future for disadvantaged children. Tuwapende Watoto means "we love children". Following this philosophy, Tanzanian employees affectionately support the orphaned and abandoned children and accompany them on their way to independence.

It is our goal for our children to receive a good education, great schooling and to improve their quality of life sustainably. The children's foundation was founded in 2005. Since 2010 the orphans live in buildings owned by the Tuwapende Watoto Foundation. In order to provide orphans and neighborhood children the best education possible, the foundation runs its own day care, nursery and primary school as well as a vocational and education training center right next to the children's home.

Education for a bright future

The Children's Home provides children with a loving home and allows them to grow up in a well-functioning community. With health prevention education and sustainability projects like our own solar system for power supply, a vegetable garden, fruit trees and chicken, the foundation improves the lives of the children and promotes their social and ecological expertise.



Since 2010, the foundation has run a Montessori nursery and since 2011 a primary school for children from the orphanage and from the surrounding villages right next to the children's home. As of January 2020, about 700 pupils are taught in our nursery and primary school. Around 20% are children from families who require financial support. We provide them an optimal education for a minor contribution to the school fees. We also set value of arts curriculum and sport and started teaching French from grade three.

Since January 2016, we take care of children from one and a half to three years old in our day care class. Also in the beginning of 2016 we opened a vocational education and training center. We help the primary and secondary school graduates by promoting their manual skills, instruct the technical understanding and convey general knowledge. Currently, we offer the following two-year apprenticeships with a dual education system: tailor, baker, gardener, electrician, electronics technician, hairdresser, computer scientist and plumber. We have the availability to train approximately 200 teenagers and young adults from our orphanage and the surrounding villages.

We currently have 90 employees. All are Tanzanian citizens with a state-approved diploma to conduct a day care center, a Montessori nursery, a primary school and a vocational education and training center and an orphanage.

Foundation Tuwapende Watoto

Tuwapende Watoto is a registered, charitable foundation based in Switzerland and a registered NGO in Tanzania. All foundation members and ambassadors are volunteer workers. Travelling costs are self-financed by the volunteers. Thanks to mainly voluntary work and an efficient organizational structure 99% (1% for administration costs for postage, audit and foundation supervision) of the donations are guaranteed to reach the children in Tanzania. The donations can be deducted from taxes throughout Switzerland.

Ambassadors


